
Mark System Instructions



Provision the safety boat (marks, inflator/deflator, anchors and anchor line reel)



Take one section of anchor line and lash it to the anchor line reel ...




... and attach it to the boat



On the way out to the course, fill the marks with the inflator (30-40 seconds for small, 2 ½ minutes for large marks)



The cylinders have an air lock that is closed by pushing in on the center post, turning to the left and releasing



Attach the anchor and throw overboard, let the anchor reel unwind by itself until it stops



Cleat the anchor line so that boat does not drift away from the mark ... use an additional 10' section of anchor line if needed



Detach the section connected to the anchor while keeping the section that is connected to the reel attached temporarily and then connect the anchor line to the bale closest to the tip of the tetrahedron



Break the connection with the anchor reel, uncleat the anchor line and send the mark overboard



Use the boat hook to bring the marks on board



Haul the anchor up ... careful not to drag the anchor fastener across the gunnel (it can catch and drop the anchor)



Method 1: let the anchor line gather where, then toss the gathered anchor line overboard to sort itself out



Method 2: continuously feed the gathered anchor line back into the lake



Disconnect anchor line from the mark (the other end is still attached to the anchor)



Connect the end that was connected to the mark and connect it to the anchor line reel



Disconnect the anchor line from the anchor and throw the loose end of the anchor line overboard and the reel in the anchor line



When done with the anchor line, loop it through on of the ends of the spool and clasp the ine upon itself



Use the deflator to deflate the marks on the way back to shore
